Alan P. Hall, age 65, of Sheffield Township, passed away peacefully at his residence on the morning of Sunday November 13, 2022. Born in Lorain on April 12, 1957, Alan was a life-long resident of Lorain County and a graduate of Clearview High School where he was a member of the school's basketball team.

He had been employed as a torch operator in the Bloom Caster at Republic Steel Corporation's Lorain Facility until the time of his retirement in 2008.

Alan was an avid outdoorsman who enjoyed camping and four-wheeling in his free time. Among his favorite destinations were trips to the Wayne National Forest located in the Appalachian Foothills in southeastern Ohio. Known as a diehard Harley Davidson enthusiast, he also displayed a broad mechanical aptitude which found him tackling a variety of garage projects including auto, motorcycle, and four-wheeler repair, as well as solving air conditioning dilemmas and a multitude of other repair challenges.
