



Anna Mae Ebinger

March 17, 1918 - March 3, 2024

Just two weeks shy of her 106th birthday, Anna Mae Ebinger passed away on Sunday March 3, 2024 at Ames Family Hospice in Westlake.

She was born March 17, 1918 in Shelby, Ohio to Earl & Elizabeth Landis (nee Longley) and had resided in Lorain since 1941.

Anna Mae graduated from Shiloh High School in 1936 where she played basketball, had the lead role in three plays and was head of the school newspaper. From 1936-1941, she worked as a cosmetologist at Myers Beauty Shoppe in Plymouth until she married Rudy Ebinger.

Anna Mae was a member of Most Pure Heart of Mary Catholic Church in Shelby. Upon moving to Lorain, she joined St Anthony of Padua Catholic Church where she became involved in the Senior Sociables and Marian Guild. She was also a charter member of the Lakeland Women's Club.

She enjoyed family, fun and laughter and was known for saying "You can't beat fun." For nearly 55 years, she spent her summers with family and friends at her cottage on Pelee Island. She enjoyed playing bridge, collecting antiques and traveling.
