Benjamin A. Caco, 86, of Lorain, passed away Tuesday February 17th 2026 at Kingston of Vermilion.

He was born February 28, 1939 in Lorain to William and Josephine (nee Krol) Caco. Ben graduated from Clearview High School in 1957 and was a standout in basketball for the Clippers. He is honored on the Clearview Wall of Fame and a member of the Lorain Sports Hall of Fame.
