



Charles Luther Hall

March 27, 1941 - March 28, 2024

Charles L. Hall, age 83, of Sheffield Township, passed away at Lake Pointe Health Care on the evening of Thursday March 28, 2024 following a period of declining health. Born in Floyd County, Kentucky on March 27, 1941, Charles moved to central Ohio in early 1960; he later moved to Lorain County where he resided for more than sixty years.

A veteran of the United States Army and former member of American Legion Post # 30, , he was employed as an arborist for the Asplundh Tree Service. He also was the founder and owner of Hall's Tree Service for more than a quarter of a century prior to his official retirement more than fifteen years ago.

Well known and well loved by many, Charles displayed a passion for vegetable gardening in his free time and was also known for his love for all animals.

Survivors include daughters Anna McKee residing in Forsythe, Georgia, and Roberta McKinney (Gregory) of West Salem, Ohio, grandchildren Hollanne Lee, Jocelyn McKee, Brant McKee, Julie Moses, Cristen Marshall, and Charles Lowe, as well as nineteen great grandchildren.
