



## Daniel Georgevich

Daniel Georgevich, 90, of Lorain, passed away Sunday November 10, 2024 at Mercy New Life Hospice in Lorain.

He was born September 17, 1934 in Huron, Ohio to Dan and Mary Georgevich (nee Tepsich).

He was a 1952 graduate of Lorain High School and worked at Sears Roebuck in Lorain and BF Goodrich in Avon Lake retiring after 26 years.

Daniel served in the Ohio National Guard with Company B, 145th Infantry Division based in Lorain.

For many years, he coached youth baseball in Lorain and Amherst and served as Cub Master for pack 345 at St Peter in Lorain for seven years. He liked playing softball and tennis and enjoyed watching the Cleveland Indians, Browns and Ohio State Buckeyes. Baseball was his all-time favorite sport and on one of his most memorable vacations he participated in the Cleveland Indians fantasy baseball camp in Winter Haven, Florida in 1994. His summer enjoyment came from attending festivals and church picnics, family vacations and planting a garden. He was very handy around the house and enjoyed working on cars. An avid classic country music fan, some of his favorite artists were Gene Autry and Hank Williams.

He is survived by his loving wife of 66 years Barbara Georgevich (nee Yontack), daughter Sandra Georgevich of Lorain, sons: David Georgevich (Laura) of Twinsburg, Don Georgevich (Ruth) of Brecksville and Bob Georgevich (Denise) of Wellington; sister Mary Toderick; brother Mike Georgevich; grandchildren: Sarah Mendak (Stephen), Samuel, Zachary, Matthew, Aaron (Jessica) and Hailey Georgevich and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, brother George Georgevich and sister Anne Thomas.
