March 31, 1927 - March 23, 2023

Felicia Arroyo (nee Cornejo), 95, of Lorain, died Thursday March 23, 2023 at her home while surrounded by her family after a brief illness.

She was born March 31, 1927 in Lorain and had been a lifelong Lorain resident.

Felicia graduated with the 1945 B Class at Lorain High School. She had worked in the Lorain city schools for Airmark Food Service and at DeLuca's Bakery. Prior to that, she had worked at US Steel and Mascon Toy.
