



## Fred Beiswenger

December 10, 1940 - February 4, 2024

Fred Beiswenger, 83, of Lorain, died Sunday February 4, 2024 at Mill Manor Nursing Home in Vermilion after an extended illness.

He was born December 10, 1940 in Lorain and had been a lifelong Lorain resident.

Fred graduated from Lorain High School in 1959 and was a founding member of the Bachelors Club at the high school. As a teenager, Fred played drums in the rock-n-roll band The Hi-Tones that played in various establishments in Lorain. An accomplished woodworker, Fred handcrafted many of the furniture pieces in his home. Along with his son Kurt, he built two street rods and enjoyed attending car shows. Fred was a Civil War buff who enjoyed traveling to Gettysburg. He enjoyed spending time with his grandsons, bowling and was an avid Cleveland Browns fan.

Fred worked at BF Goodrich in Avon Lake where he was a supervisor retiring in 2000 after 40 years. Prior to that, he had worked at the Lorain Ford Assembly Plant for 7 years. He was a member of St John United Church of Christ in Lorain where he served on church council and was an usher and greeter.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years Gayle Beiswenger (nee Sensheimer);

children: Kurt Beiswenger (Pamela) and Eric Beiswenger (Linda), all of Lorain; grandsons: Kyle & Kody Beiswenger; step grandchildren: Jared Tucker (Trisha) and Katelyn Bandagski; 5 step great grandchildren and sister Marlene Holko. He was preceded in death by his parents Frederick "Fritz" Beiswenger and Victoria Beiswenger (nee Drexler) and sister Lois Nickoloff.

The family will receive friends Friday February 9, 2024 from 10:00 am until the time of funeral services at 12:00 pm at the Gluvna-Shimo-Hromada Funeral Chapel, 3224 Broadway, Lorain.
