Helen G. Taylor (nee Calderaro), age 98, of Lorain, passed away at Mercy Health Lorain Hospital on the morning of Tuesday April 16, 2024 following a period of declining health. Helen was born in Amherst and had been a long-time resident of Lorain. She was a graduate of Lorain High School.

In her earlier years she had been employed as a sales associate in the jewelry department of Big Town on Oberlin Avenue as well as a clerk for Tony's Meats on East 28th Street.

Helen was a regular parishioner of the former St. Stanislaus Catholic Church; since the church's closure, she had been a member of St. Peter Parish.

Helen spent her life dedicated and devoted to her immediate and extended family. Skilled in the craft of knitting and crocheting, she also enjoyed cooking and baking in her free time.
