



James S. "Zest" Liskiewicz

James S. "Zest" Liskiewicz, 78, of Amherst, died Tuesday January 16, 2024 at Ames Family Hospice House in Westlake after a long illness.

He was born June 15, 1945 in Buffalo, New York and had resided in Amherst since 1976 moving from Lorain.

Jim graduated from Marion Steele High School in Amherst in 1963 and began working at Span Master Crain until he was drafted into the Army and served in Vietnam from September 1966 to August 1967. When he returned home, he resumed his employment at Span Master until their closing then went to work at York International for 10 years until their closing. Later, he worked in maintenance at the Lorain County Detention Home retiring after 10 years.

Jim enjoyed model trains and had a railroad train setup in his basement. He was an avid Buffalo Bills fan and fan of the gameshow Jeopardy where he always knew most of the answers. He enjoyed spending time with his nieces and nephews and watching baseball and football. He was a member of American Legion #118 and VFW Post #1662, both in Amherst, AMVETS Post #22 in Vermilion and Eagles Aerie # 1442 in Amherst.

He is survived by his wife of 52 years Cindy Liskiewicz (nee Lukachko), several nieces and nephews and brother-in-law John Lukachko (Peggy) of

Denver, North Carolina. He was preceded in death by his parents Stanley & Florence Liskiewicz (nee Uzarowski).
