



## Judith Drop

September 13, 1947 - February 6, 2025

Judith “Judy” Drop (nee Goldyn), 77, of Lorain, died unexpectedly at her home on Thursday February 6, 2025.

She was born September 13, 1947 in Cleveland to Anthony & Lois Goldyn (nee Weiss). She grew up in Cleveland and had lived most of her life in Lorain.

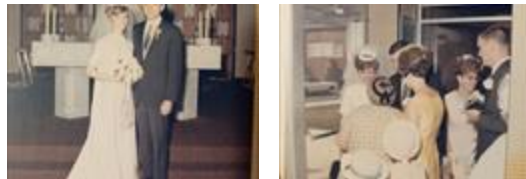
