Linda Jurasin (nee DeLeonardis), 75, of Lorain, died unexpectedly on Friday September 15, 2023 in the emergency room at Mercy Health Lorain.

She was born August 26, 1948 in Lorain to Emerick & Rose DeLeonardis (nee Kodman). Linda lived in Amherst for the past 3 years and had spent her winters in Surprise, Arizona for the past 15 years.

Linda graduated from Clearview High School. She earned a Master's Degree in Executive Management from Ashland University and also had an Associate Degree in Accounting and Bachelor Degree in Business.

She worked at Nordson Corporation in Amherst as a Lead Corporate Quality Auditor retiring in 2008 after 30 years.

She was a member of ASQ, Exemplar Global, St Peter Parish and St Clare of Assisi in Surprise, Arizona. Linda enjoyed glass fusion, travel, music and playing games on her cell phone.

She is survived by her son James J. Jurasin of Euclid, granddaughter Lilianna Jurasin of Lorain and 2 sisters. She was preceded in death by her husband of 53 years James E. Jurasin in 2022 and her parents.
