



## Marcella Ann Astorino

November 2, 1938 - December 3, 2024

With profound sadness and hearts full of love, we announce the passing of Marcella Ann Astorino on December 3, 2024. A devoted wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother and friend, Marcella touched countless lives with her kindness, warmth, and unwavering faith. As a long-time active member of St John Roman Catholic Church (now St Frances Cabrini Catholic Church), she served on the finance committee, sung in the choir, served as a Eucharistic Minister, taught PSR classes and was a member of the Holy Name Society. As a volunteer for Birthright, Marcella would sell flowers in church during Mother's Day and decorate a Christmas Giving Tree to help raise money and provide gifts for the children.
