Marcella A. "Marcie" Matotek (nee Marmol), 85, of Lorain, died Monday January 23, 2023 at Amherst Manor Nursing Home after a short illness.

She was born August 30, 1937 in Lorain and had been a lifelong Lorain resident.

Marcie graduated from Lorain High School in 1955. She worked as a telephone operator for the Lorain Telephone Company and at Lorain Products where she soldered circuit boards. For many years, Marcie worked at the John J. Gluvna Funeral Chapel and Gluvna-Shimo-Hromada Funeral Chapel organizing and preparing food for funeral luncheons.

She was a member of the former Holy Trinity Catholic Church, Slovak Catholic Sokols, St Ann's Lodge Branch #114 and St Peter Parish. She enjoyed exercising with the Silver Sneakers group, walking, reading, traveling and cooking holiday meals for her family.

She is survived by her husband of 54 years John E. Matotek, sons: Tim Riley (Tammie Houston), John Matotek and Steve Matotek and grandchildren: Bryan & Chelsea Matotek. She was preceded in death by her first husband Sam Riley in 1958, parents John & Mary Marmol (nee Pastirchak), brother John J. Marmol in 1994 and sister Mary Luca in 2005.
