Marton J. Super, age 74, of Lorain, passed away on Saturday August 17, 2024. He is preceded in death by his beloved mother, Dorothy Super, and his dear sister, Carol Patton. Marty is survived by his brother Michael A. Super (Karen) of Grafton and his sister Nancy McClear (Don) of Avon, as well as nieces, Brigid Whelan (Justin), Kaitlyn Martin (Kevin), and Kathleen Kucaj (Brian), nephew Kyle McClear (Jenny), and grandnephews Patrick and Danny and grandniece Nell.

Marty was born in 1950 in Toledo, Ohio, and lived in Lorain most of his life. He attended Lorain High School and enlisted in the Army in September 1968, receiving an honorable discharge in May 1970. Marty's service in the Vietnam War as Army PFC was among his proudest accomplishments, earning him numerous awards including the Vietnam Gallantry Cross with Palm and the Bronze Star Medal. Friends and family closest to him knew him by his nickname, "Chief." Marty had a passion for working on cars. He especially loved restoring classic cars, with his pride and joy being his 1959 Corvette that he and his mother enjoyed taking for drives in the country. He was also a skilled leather craftsman, creating various treasures for friends and family.

A graveside funeral service will be held at Calvary Cemetery in Lorain on Friday September 13, 2024, at 11:00 a.m. The Rev. Neil Walters, pastor of St Vincent de Paul Catholic Church, will preside. Military honors will be

conducted by AMVETS Post #32.
