Mary Ann (Marie) Milde (nee Rybarczyk), age 82, of New Russia Township, passed away peacefully at her residence on the evening of Monday October 10th, 2022 following a brief illness. She was born in Lorain on July 10, 1940 and was a graduate of Lorain High School.

Mary Ann began her working career as a secretary for the Lorain News. Later, she served as a bookkeeper at the Oberlin Country Day Camp and subsequently as a cafeteria aide and tutor at St. Stanislaus Parochial School in Lorain. Prior to her retirement in 2005, she had been employed as a cafeteria worker at St. Vincent de Paul Parish School in Elyria Township.

A long-time parishioner and Altar and Rosary Society member at St. Vincent de Paul, Mary Ann also once belonged to the Ladies Farmer Club, as well as the Polish Legion of American Veterans and its traveling P.L.A.V. Drill Team.

In her leisure time she enjoyed crocheting, knitting, and quilting; she also was an avid reader with a preference for romance novels. Most of all, she enjoyed cooking and entertaining for her family and friends.
