Nancy Ann Leuzzi (nee Majzun), 80, of Lorain, died Tuesday March 26, 2024 at Main Street Care Center in Avon Lake after a long illness.

She was born October 8, 1943 in Lorain to John & Eva Majzun (nee Evanoff) and had been a lifelong Lorain resident.

Nancy Ann graduated from Clearview High School where she played clarinet in the marching band.

She was a member of the former St Vitus Catholic Church in Lorain, the St Teresa Guild, and the Lorain Historical Society. An active volunteer, she served on the St Ladislaus School PTO where she was past president, created a cookbook of recipes from St Ladislaus parishioners, served on the board of Lorain Catholic High School and helped with bingo and volunteered with the Lorain Palace Theater.

Nancy Ann enjoyed gardening and baking and had made many custom decorated wedding cakes.

She is survived by her husband of 56 years Joseph D. Leuzzi, sons: Joseph Leuzzi (Kim) of Parma, John Leuzzi (Sabrina) of North Ridgeville and James Leuzzi of Strongsville; grandsons: J.D. and Anthony Leuzzi and brothers John Majzun and Chris Majzun (Marcie), all of Amherst. She was preceded in death

by her parents.
