



Peter "Uncle Pete" Mahalow

April 12, 1932 - December 13, 2023

Peter "Uncle Pete" Mahalow, 91, of Vermilion Township, died Wednesday December 13, 2023 while under the care of his niece Debra Seronka and her husband Tom at their home after a cancer illness.

Pete was born April 12, 1932 in Hazleton, Pennsylvania and had lived there most of his life until moving to Vermilion Township in March of 2020 to live with his niece and nephew.

He served as a medic with the US Army during the Korean War. He was awarded the Korean Service Medal with 1 Bronze Service Star and the United Nations Service Medal.

Pete worked at Westinghouse in New Jersey and Johnson & Johnson in New Jersey retiring in 1994.

He was a member of St John the Baptist Byzantine Rite Catholic Church in Hazleton Township, Pennsylvania, the AMVETS Post # 22 and American Legion Post # 397, both of Vermilion and was a life member of VFW Post # 229 in Manville, New Jersey.

Pete was an avid fan of the New York Yankees, New York Giants and Penn State football. He enjoyed attending auto cruise-ins, collecting die cast cars,

dancing polkas, eating out and socializing.

He is survived by nieces and nephews: Debra Seronka (Thomas), Joseph Mahalow, JoAnn Yoakem (Richard), June Kennedy & Robert Yenchko (Mary), dear friend Jodi Cohan, faithful dog and companion Cooper & his son Peter S. Mahalow. He was preceded in death by his parents Michael & Mary Mihalov (nee Kichka), infant twin brothers Nikola & Stefan Mihalov, sisters Ann Powers, Susan Pacelli & Mary Yenchko, brothers: John, Michael, George, Joseph & Andrew Mahalow, niece Marie Malley and nephew Michael Yenchko.

The family will receive friends Saturday, December 16, 2023 at St Nicholas Byzantine Rite Catholic Church, 2711 W 40th St, Lorain for the Divine Liturgy starting at 11:00 am.
