Peter W. Rahotina, 77, of Sheffield Village, died Sunday March 3, 2024 at the Cleveland Clinic Avon Hospital after a long illness.

He was born March 26, 1946 in Elyria to William & Juanita Rahotina (nee Traxler) and had resided in Sheffield Village most of his life.

Pete graduated from Brookside High School in 1964 and served with the US Army National Guard for six years.
