Rose Mihok Bendik (nee Evans) went to her heavenly home on the evening of Saturday, September 21st at the age of 101. She was born October 20, 1922 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and graduated from David B. Oliver High School as a member of the Class of 1941.
