Sarah Robles (nee Marrero), 88, of Lorain, died peacefully Sunday June 18, 2023 at Oak Hills Nursing Center in Lorain after a lengthy illness.

She was born May 25, 1935 in Hormigueros, Puerto Rico and had resided in Lorain most of her life.

During the 1950's, Sarah was known as the "Jewelry Lady" in South Lorain where she sold gold jewelry for many years. She worked in the Paint Department at the Ford Truck Plant in Avon Lake for 19 years before retiring. She also attended the Northern Institute of Cosmetology in Lorain and worked as a Beautician for many years. She had won awards for her work in cosmetology.
