Sherry D. Rogers-Miller, age 75, of New Russia Township, passed away peacefully at her residence on the evening of Monday September 19, 2022 following an extended illness.

Sherry was born in Middletown, Ohio on May 24, 1947 and had been a resident of Lorain County since her childhood. She was a 1968 graduate of Oberlin High School.
